- Gingher G8 8" Dressmaker Shears
- Gingher G4 4" Embroidery Scissors (or Equivalent for Trimming Threads)
- Gingher G5 5" Tailor Point Scissors (Optional)
- Paper Scissors
- Pencil
- Clover Chaco Liner Tailor's Chalk or Equivalent
- Collins Styling Design Ruler
- 60" Fiberglass Tape Measure
- Sewing Gauge
- Collins Point Turner
- Clover Long Handled Seam Ripper
- Buttonhole Chisel
- Glass Head Pins
- Fray Check
- Hump Jumper
- Klassé Sewing Machine Needles, Size 90, Sharp and Size 110, Jeans
- Baby Lock Bobbin
- Jeans Pattern (Kwik Sew 3504 for Men, 3193 for Women – for Plus Sizes, speak with Russell)
- 7 to 10 oz Denim or Plain Twill Weave 100% Cotton Fabric in Yardage Required for Your Size (NOTE: If you are uncertain whether or not a particular fabric is suitable for use with this project, consult with the instructor prior to purchase. STRETCH DENIMS ARE INAPPROPRIATE FOR THIS PROJECT.)
- 2 Spools Metrosene Polyester Thread to Match (If you want Blue Jeans Gold, it is color 658)
- One Jeans Button
- Rivets (Optional)
- Punch Plier (Optional but will be needed if you are installing rivets)
- One Trouser/Jeans Zipper, 9 Inch
- 1/3 Yard of Cotton Fabric for Front Pockets
